MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CHAMBERS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #1

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners ("Board" or "Commissioners") of the Chambers County Emergency Services District No. 1 ("District") was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on the 11th day of October 2023, at the Winnie-Stowell Volunteer Fire Department ("WSVFD" or "Department") located at 825 State Highway 124, Winnie, Texas 77665 pursuant to notice duly posted according to law.

Members of the public were asked to attend in person or allowed to participate by conference call. In addition, a recording of the meeting is available upon request.

The roll was called of the Commissioner, to-wit:

President Murrell called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. and lead the meeting. First, he asked those present to recite the Pledge of Allegiance and Pledge

to the State Flag of Texas. Next, he asked for public comment and since there were none, President Murrell called on the Commissioners to consider the action items on the agenda.

Agenda Item No. 4 - To discuss approval of minutes for September 13, 2023 Regular Meeting.

The President directed the Commissioners to Agenda Item No. 4 and requested that the Commissioners review the minutes of the September 13, 2023 Regular Meeting.

Thereafter, Commissioner Thibodeaux made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 13, 2023 Regular Minutes. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Barrow and unanimously approved by all the Commissioners.

Agenda Item No. 5 - Discuss and take-action, on the District's Treasurer's Report; District's expenses; and amend the District's budget, if necessary.

Mrs. Hardy was then called on to present the District's financial reports and Treasurer's report. (*See* Exhibit "A-1"). According to Mrs. Hardy, on October 11, 2023, the District checking account balance was \$342,558.55 and the Comptroller's payment in the amount of \$61,343.19 was anticipated to be deposited on October 13, 2023. After the Comptroller's payment is received, the District's checking account balance will be \$403,901.75. Following payment of invoices of \$23,673.82 and \$1,220.04 for payroll taxes the ending balance in the checking account will be - \$379,007.88. However, since the check in the amount of \$320,794.00 to Siddons Martin for the Mini-Pumper had not been deposited yet, Mrs. Hardy recommended against transferring any money from the operations account to a money market account.

Turning to the invoices due, Mrs. Hardy, reported that the invoices to be paid at the meeting totaled \$23,673.82 (*See* Exhibit "A-1"). This month, Mrs. Hardy noted that there were no invoices that were out of normal. Regarding the District's savings accounts, Mrs. Hardy informed the Commissioners that as of the meeting, the balance in the accounts were as follows:

- <u>East Chambers Money Market</u>: The balance in the Money Market account was \$713,727.62 after taking into account the withdrawal of \$175,000.00 for the mini-pumper and the \$221.91 in interest paid;
- <u>Texas First Bank Money Market</u>: This money market account increased by \$356.90 to \$289,842.57 from the prior meeting;
- <u>Common Cents Credit Union</u>: The balance in the Common Cents account increased to \$233,187.38 after receipt of the quarterly interest payment of \$2,426.35; and
- <u>Prosperity Bank</u>: The account balance for this account remained the same at \$233,805.40.
- <u>Combined Bank Balances</u>: Combined, Mrs. Hardy informed the Commissioners that the District's total cash assets were \$1,541,115.46 after the invoices were paid.

(See Exhibit "A-1").

Additionally, the Commissioners were presented with reports for: 1) Aged Payables; 2) Account reconciliation for each account; 3) Account Registers for each account; and 4) Financials for September 2023. They then reviewed and briefly discussed the September 2023 Income Statement and Balance Sheet. *See* Exhibit "A-2".

Once all reports were reviewed, the Commissioners thanked Mrs. Hardy for the financial reports. Thereafter, Commissioner Dow made a motion to approve the following: 1) Treasurer's Report; 2) the District September 2023 Financial Reports; and 2) pay the outstanding invoices. Commissioner Thibodeaux seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously approved with the consent of all the Commissioners.

Agenda Item No. 6 – Receive reports from the Administrator and Fire Chief, including the Department's Financial Report.

President Murrell then called on Administrator Hardy to give her

Administrator report. (*See* Exhibit "B"). Accordingly, Mrs. Hardy reported on the following:

- The DEF pump for E22 was still on back order.
- The Station had a power surge which caused the third leg of power coming into the station to be dropped. Since then, Quality Air was called out to repair the breaker for the mini-splits.
- In addition, the 3M cascade compressor has not been working and the District was waiting on parts from 3M to repair the compressor.
- The County Burn Ban has been lifted.
- The County will be coming to the station on Monday, October 16, 2023 to begin installing a station radio and speakers.
- Next Blood Drive is scheduled for November 3, 2023.
- The District was working with the Department for Fire Prevention Week and going to the library on October 20, 2023 to end the Coloring contest that the Department hosted with the library.
- The District upstaffed for the Rice Festival weekend; however, there event was uneventful.

After the Commissioners reviewed and discussed the Administrator's Report, President Murrell called on the Chief to present his monthly report. This month, the Chief reported that in September 2023, the District and the Department responded to one-hundred and eleven (111) calls. A summary of the calls is set forth below:

In addition, the Chief discussed the following:

- September call volume was slightly higher due to a higher number of brush/grass fires in our district as well as mutual aid.
- The Department has been receiving more requests for mutual aid to neighboring departments.
- The Department was completing a Texas Forestry Service PPE grant that will give the Department five (5) full sets of turnout gear for firefighting personnel.
- The Department was nearly complete with preparing and filing the County Funding packet for 2024 by November 1, 2023.
- The Department was researching equipment purchases for Rescue 21 such as High Angle and Confined Space technical rescue equipment.
- Brush 22, the side-by-side, was striped with the Department and the District's markings at no cost.

Lastly, the Chief directed the Commissioners to their packets for a copy of the complete run report, statistical reports, and bank account summaries. (*See* Exhibit "C").

Agenda Item No. 7 – Discuss and take-action, if necessary, on purchasing fire or EMS equipment and/or supplies as well as any proposed repairs, maintenance and/or testing.

No action was taken on this Agenda Item.

Agenda Item No. 8 – Discuss and take-action, if necessary, to declare property surplus and/or salvage property.

Administrator Hardy asked to table this agenda item because Staff will not be able to properly evaluate surplus and/or salvage property until the new mini-pumper is delivered.

In response, Commissioner Barrow made a motion to table this agenda item. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Thibodeaux and unanimously approved with the consent of all the Commissioners.

There being no further business, President Murrell informed the Commissioners that the next meeting would take place on November 8, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. He then called for a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:25 p.m. Commissioner Dow then made a motion to adjourn. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Crone with the unanimous consent of all the Commissioners present.

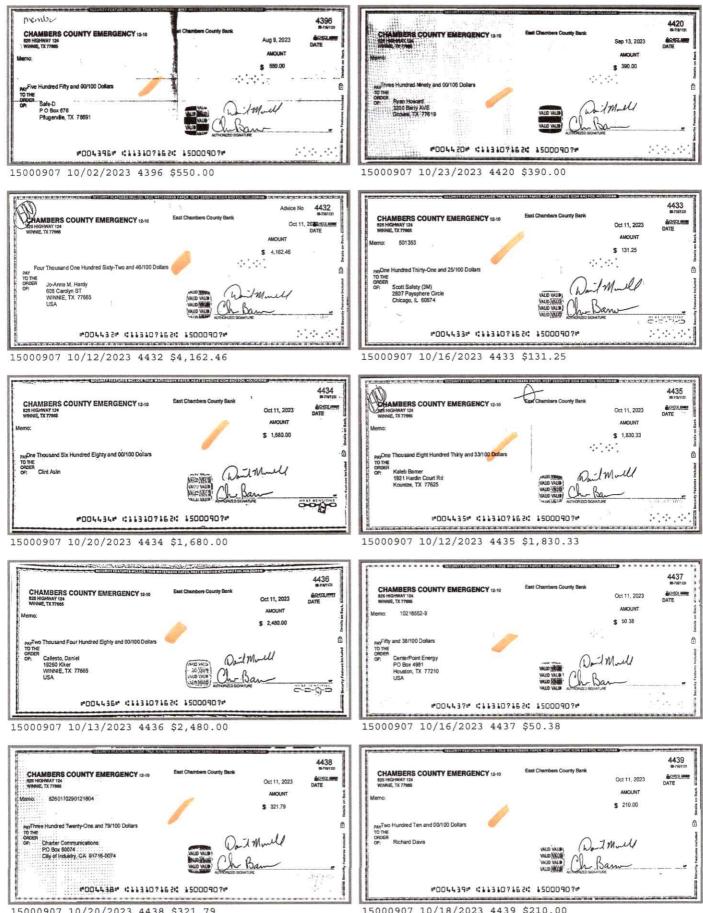

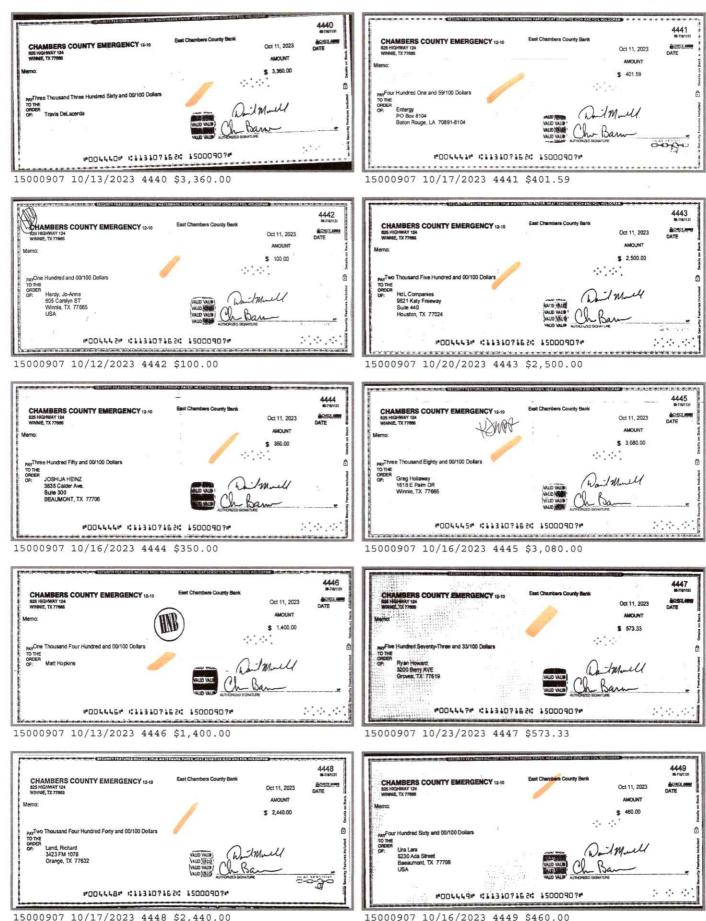

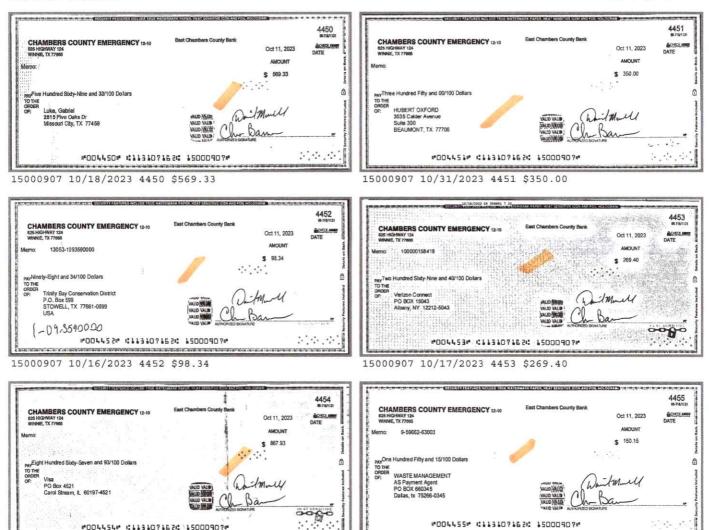
